3 Write a story about a character who finds a jeweled box that has a secret message inside. Who finds the box? What does the secret message say? What does the character do next?



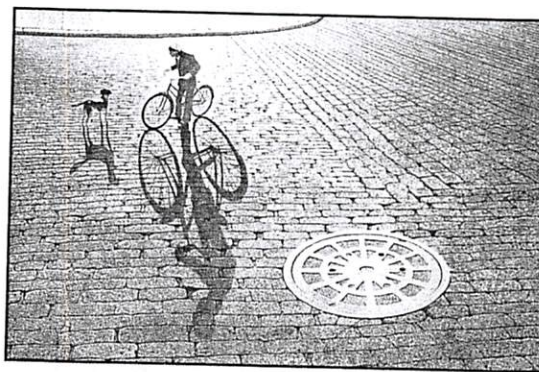
4 What would it be like to live on the moon? What would everyday life be like? What problems could happen? Write a story about a character living in a moon colony one hundred years from now.
